

MIRIAM CENTRE

Miriam Centre has been serving the community since 1988. The Centre receives no funding from the government. It could not exist without the generosity of its loyal supporters and the proceeds from various fundraising events.

As important as it has been and continues to be for Miriam Centre, this type of funding never really provided the level of stable and predictable income necessary for the efficient operation of any organization. This led to the creation of a sister organization in 1998.

MIRIAM CENTRE FOUNDATION

The Foundation is an autonomous organization, with its own Board of Directors, whose sole mission is to help Miriam Centre meet its financial requirements. The Foundation collects and invests the donations it receives; only the interest produced by the investment of this capital is transferred to Miriam Centre.

In other words, while donations to Miriam Centre are used to cover ongoing expenses, donations to the Foundation are an investment in the future of Miriam Centre. Among other things, donations to the Foundation make long-term planning much easier, as they guarantee that funds will always be available to finance at least some of the work done by Miriam Centre.

PLANNED GIVING

Planned giving is another way of helping Miriam Centre. It consists in making arrangements for the Centre or the Foundation to receive money (or other assets) in a will. Furthermore, the ownership of a life insurance policy can be transferred to Miriam Centre or the Foundation. Donations will result in tax benefits that can be significant. A planned donation is an efficient way of making sure that Miriam Centre will have, in perpetuity, the means to continue its good work.
